South End Landmark Protection Area Design Review Standards GSDM Project Compliance

Demolition

A one-story addition to the original building will be demolished. The main structure will remain with a new 2-story addition wrapping a seven-story addition and re-cladding to unify the structure.

Land Coverage

Building setbacks from the property line to the existing building will not change. The new seven—story addition will be set back approximately 6'-4" off the property boundary along East Newton Street. The new receiving area walls will abut the property boundary on Albany Street.

Height of Structures

By way of illustration, although the proposed project is subject to IMP approval, the proposed height is below the 120' Albany – Harrison Avenue zoning limitation.

Landscape










Site Plan
