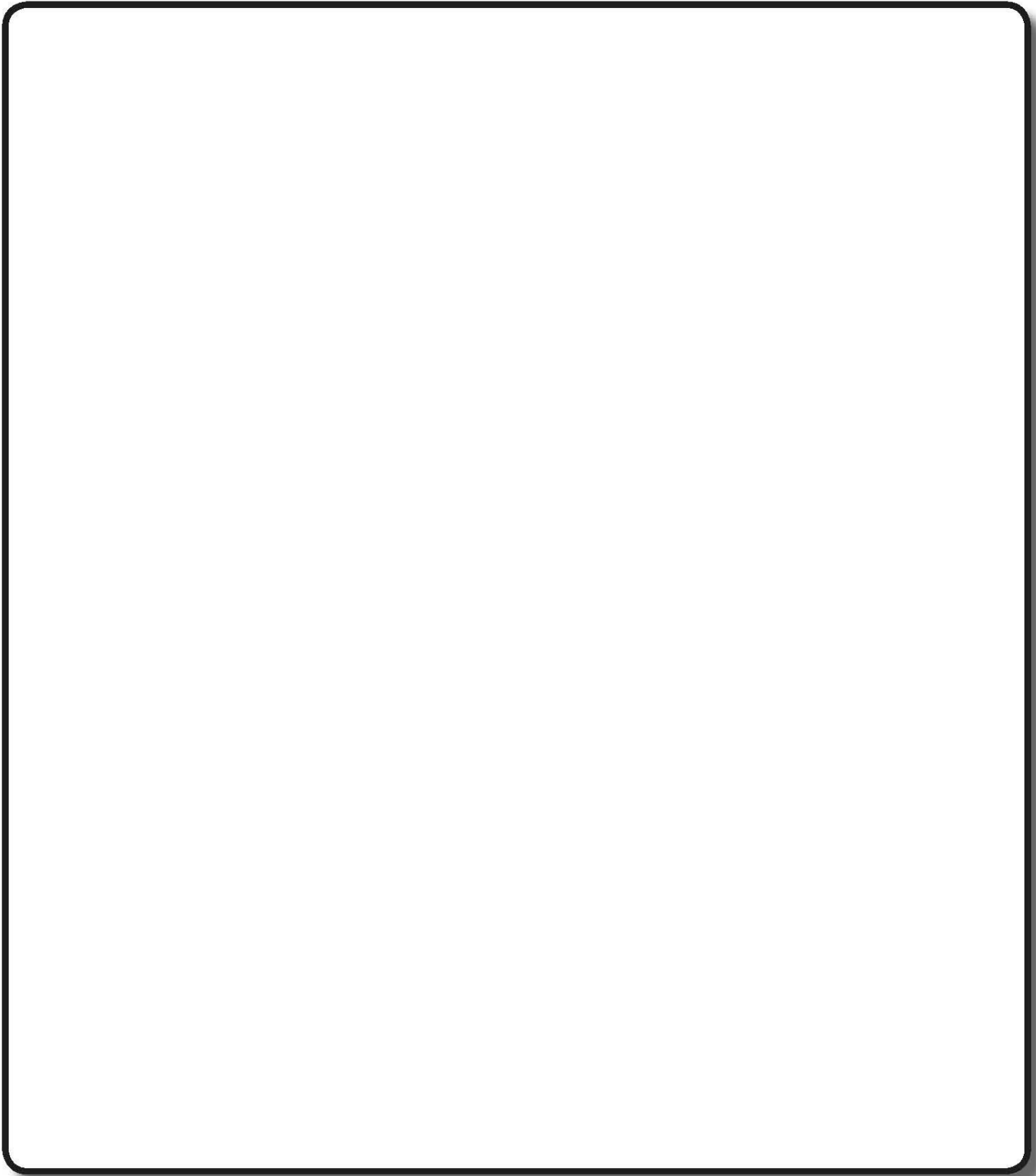




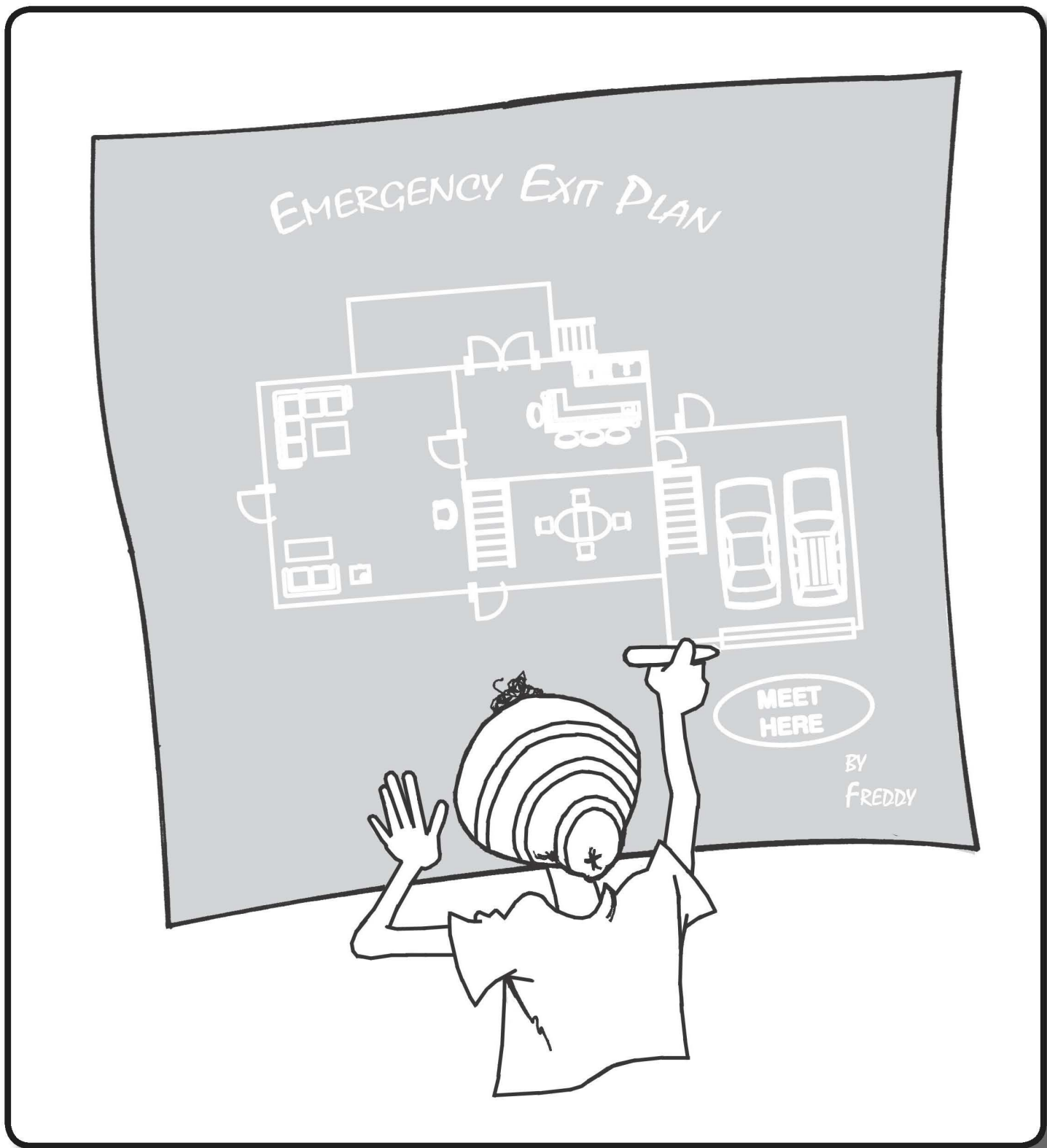
Preparing for an emergency is like getting ready to go on an adventure. You need to make plans, get the supplies you need. Learn as much as you can about emergency situations before one really happens.



This is Freddy and this is where he lives.

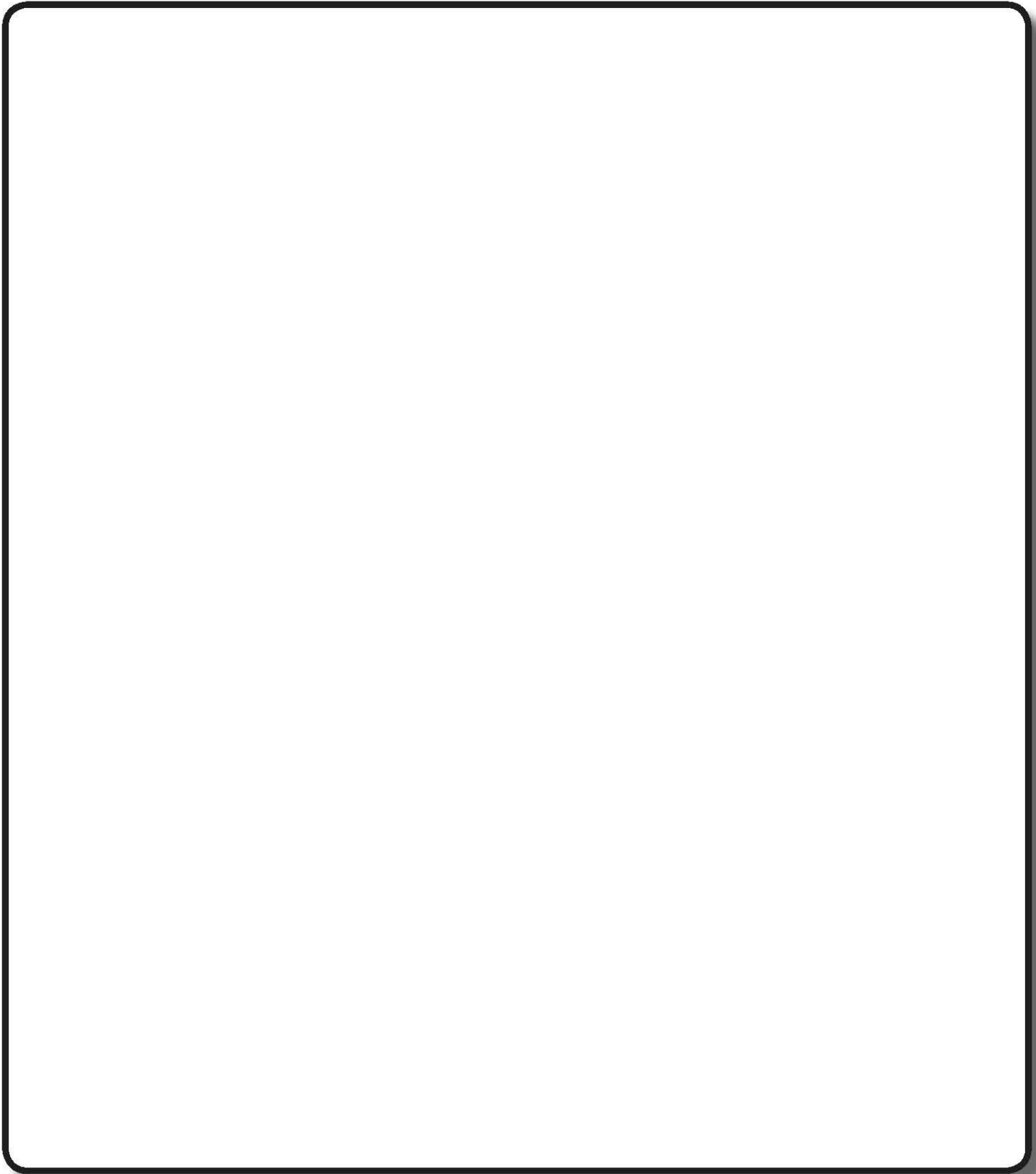


Draw a picture of your house.

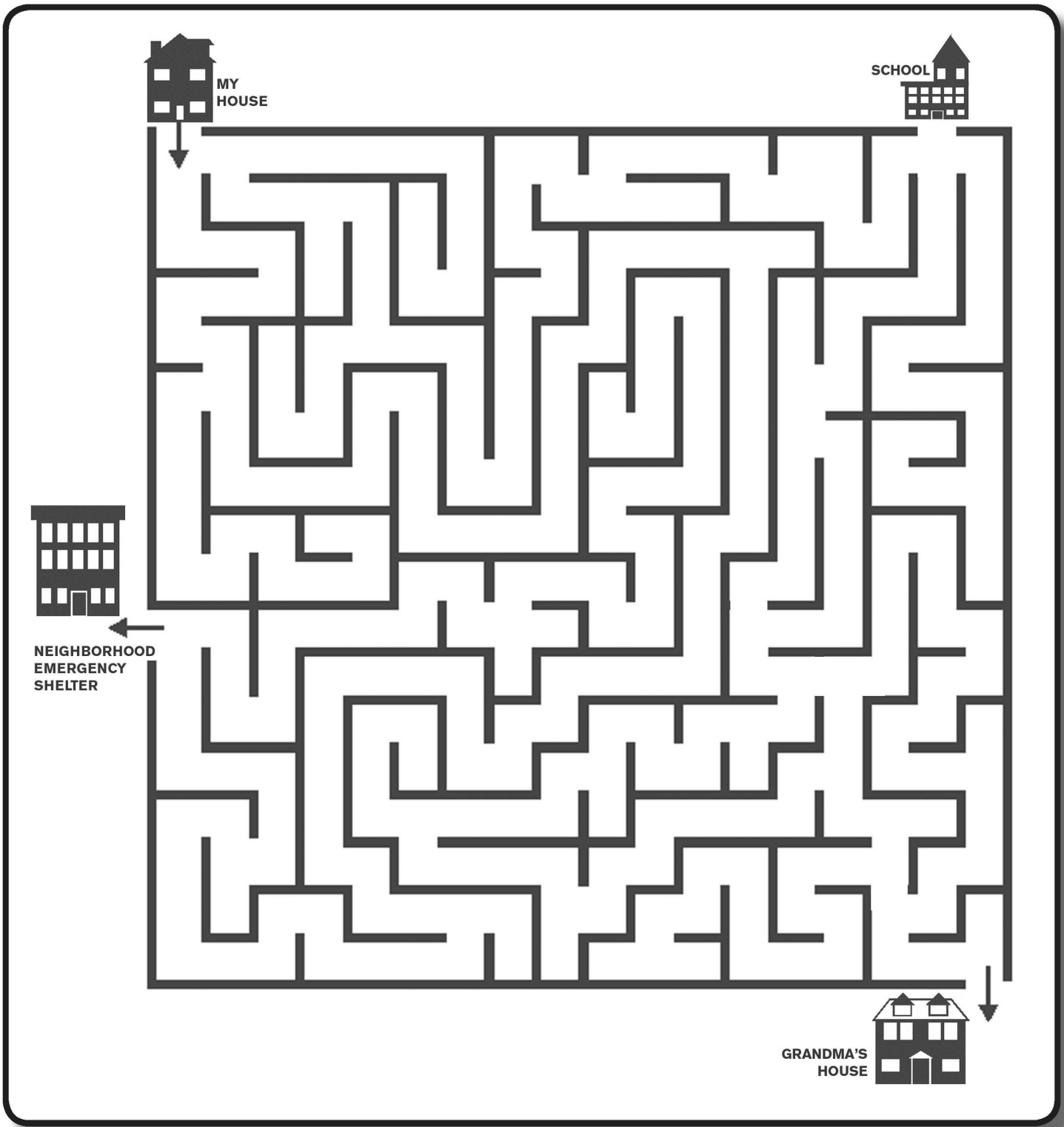
Use this keypad to practice dialing 9-1-1


What IMPORTANT NUMBERS do you need to know?

Write down the numbers and practice calling them on the phone key pad.



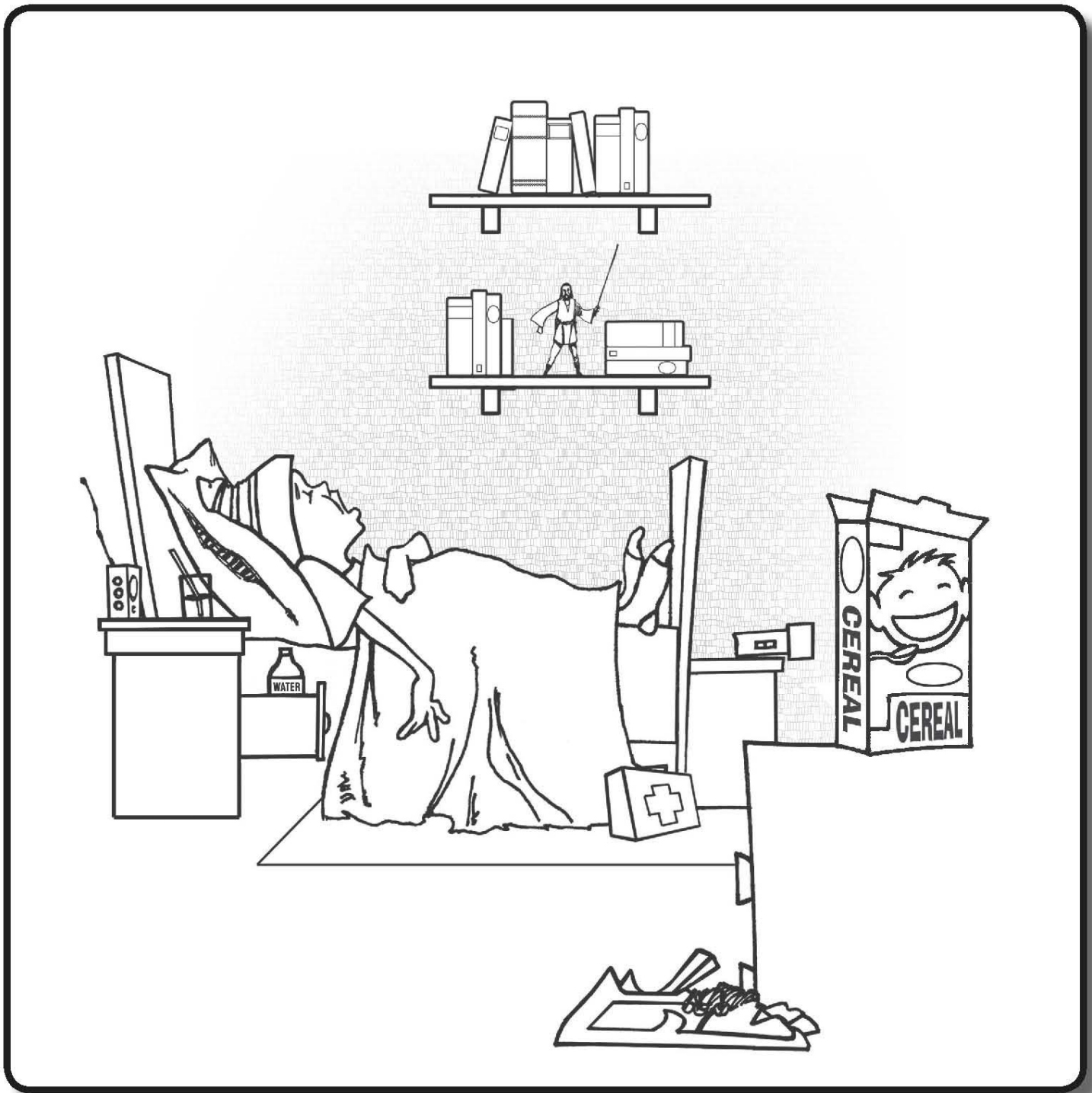
The next part of Freddy's plan is to come up with two places his family can go during an emergency.

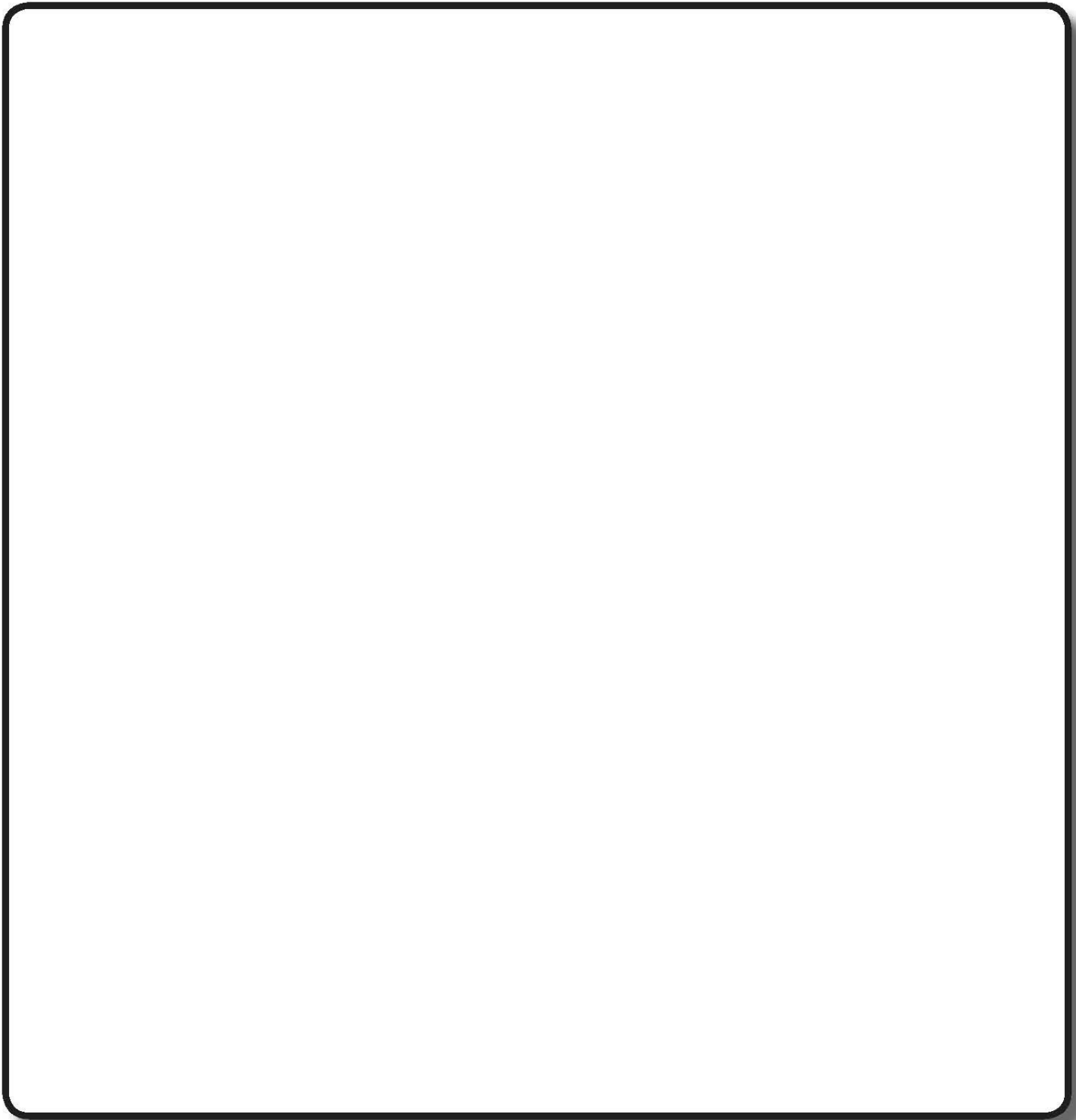

- Flashlight**
- First Aid Kit**
- Dust Masks**
