AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND FY20 Co-Response Grant FUNDS, AWARDED BY MA Department of Mental Health.

WHEREAS, the MA Department of Mental Health, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of ONE HUNDRED THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED THIRTEEN DOLLARS (**\$103,413.00**) would fund a full-time Master's-level Mental Health Clinician to co-respond with officers in Police Districts B-2 and B-3, and a part-time Certified Peer Specialist. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the MA Department of Mental Health, FY20 Co-Response Grant award not to exceed the amount of ONE HUNDRED THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED THIRTEEN DOLLARS (**\$103,413.00**).
