ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the Massachusetts Executive Office of Health and Human Services, FY20 and FY21 Safe and Successful Youth Initiative award not to exceed the amount of TWO MILLION ONE HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,160,000.00).
