I hereby transmit for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of FOUR HUNDRED THIRTEEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$413,472.00) in the form of a grant, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant FY18, awarded by the United States Department Of Justice to be administered by the Police Department.

WHEREAS, the the United States Department Of Justice, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of FOUR HUNDRED THIRTEEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$413,472.00) would fund 3 Domestic Violence Advocates assigned to police districts, a Management Analyst at the Family Justice Center, and a Technology Coordinator for multiple data collection, reporting and records management systems. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the the United States Department Of Justice, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant FY18 award not to exceed the amount of FOUR HUNDRED THIRTEEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$413,472.00).
