#### **Design Review**

20.108 BV

67-69 Church Street

Proposed Work: Amend Application 19.1160 BV to adjust the approved design of the first-story by restoring the brick piers in a symmetric manner and in alignment with the existing brick areas of the second-story.

Representative: Anthony Piermarini

Mr. Piermarini presented photos of existing conditions, plans for the previously approved work, and plans for proposed work. He explained that the proposed changes are to the Shawmut Avenue first floor only and will allow for the re-use of portions of the existing structural steel and concrete, and will consolidate entry areas making for a more symmetrical and balanced façade in relationship to the existing building.

The Commission discussed the symmetry of the building and agreed that the proposed changes are sympathetic to the building. The Commission questioned the choice of materials for the windows and doors, and ask for clarification on the detail of the panels below the first-story windows.

There was no public comment.

In conclusion the Commission voted to approve the application with provisos citing that the proposed work honors the original design of the building and re-uses existing building material. However, the Commission stipulated that the base of the first-story windows be designed to have recessed lower panels with details remanded to staff for review.

Commissioner McDermott initiated the motion and Commissioner Knopf seconded the motion. The vote was 4-0.
