AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT AWARD IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THIRTY MILLION DOLLARS (\$30,000,000) FROM THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF DEDICATED BUS LANES AND SIMILAR BUS PRIORITY MEASURES IN VARIOUS LOCATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

ORDERED: That the Boston Transportation Department, acting on behalf of the City of Boston, be, and hereby is, authorized pursuant to Section 53A of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend a grant award in an amount not to exceed Thirty Million Dollars (\$30,000,000) from the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority, for the construction and implementation of dedicated bus lanes and similar bus priority measures in various locations within the City of Boston.
