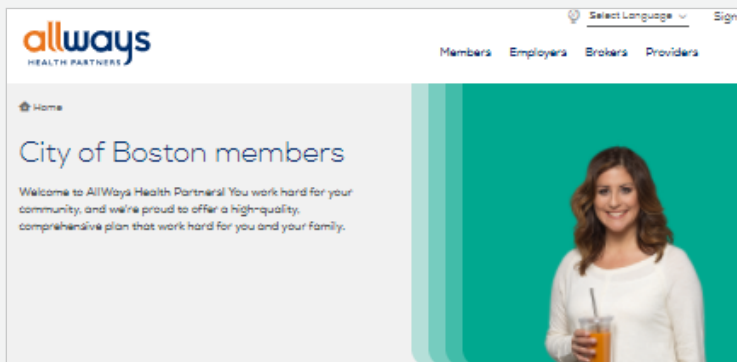


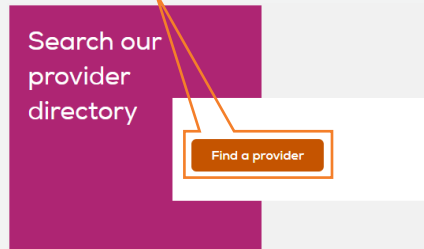


# How to find participating doctors, hospitals, and more

**1** Visit [allwayshealthpartners.org/cityofboston](https://allwayshealthpartners.org/cityofboston) to search for providers.



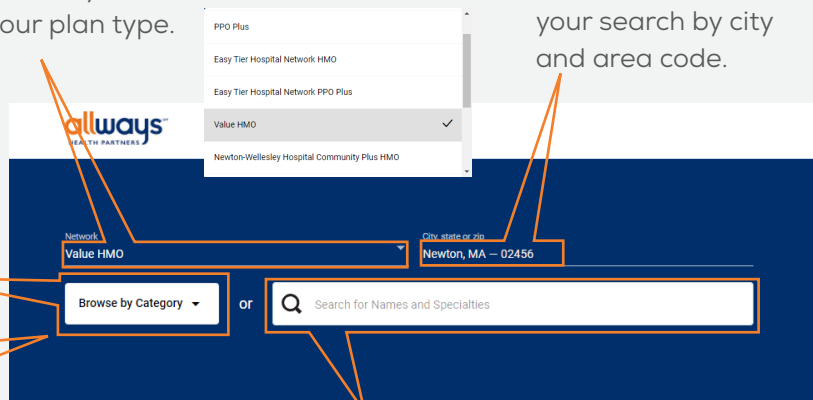
**2** Use this link to search doctors, hospitals, and more.



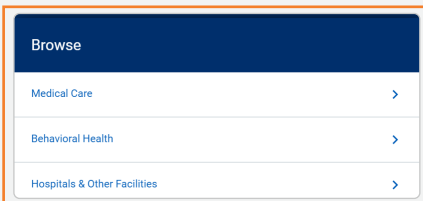
**3** Use the search bar to find a specific type of provider. Start by selecting your plan type and setting your location using your zip code.

You can choose a category to search.



You can also type in provider name or specialty to refine your search.

## Definition of Status

Icon	Status	Definition
<b>TIER 1</b>	Tier 1	This tier includes lower cost generic medications. Generic drugs contain the same active ingredients as their brand name counterparts.
<b>TIER 2</b>	Tier 2	This tier includes other generics and may include some brand name medications.
<b>TIER 3</b>	Tier 3	This tier includes higher costing generic and preferred brand name medications.
<b>\$0</b>	Zero Copay	This tier includes medications available at a zero dollar copay.
