Before applying for the Rental Relief Fund, make sure you have access to the following documents:

- Photo identification for head of household
- Signed lease, tenancy agreement, or tenancy-at-will form
- Documentation of income eligibility (select one of the following)
 - Last two pay stubs
 - Proof of unemployment benefits
 - Verification letter for SNAP or MassHealth
 - No income/cash income verification form
- Documentation of housing instability (select one of the following)
 - Notice of arrears or balance overdue
 - Court summons
 - Notice to quit
 - Notice of eviction
 - Letter from host if doubled up
- Utility bill (ONLY for households applying for utility assistance)
