The Boston City Council's Committee on Small Business and Workforce Development will hold a hearing on **Monday, October 4, 2021 at 11:00 AM**. This hearing will be held virtually.

The subject of the hearing is:

Docket #0957, message and order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of Two Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Four Dollars (\$254,194.00) in the form of a grant, for the Challenge Grant, awarded by the William T. Grant Foundation, passed through Northeastern University, to be administered by the Department of Youth Engagement & Employment.

This matter was sponsored by the Administration, and was referred to the Committee on September 15, 2021.
