


CONNECT DOWNTOWN



Curb extension along start/end of Mall on western side of Arlington


New/relocated post-mounted pedestrian signals

Small concrete curb extensions for directional ramps Replace or repair brick as needed along Public Garden






3. ARLINGTON/BOYLSTON

MATERIALS: SIDEWALKS AND RAMPS




