Scope	Location	Description
Overview	Front Facade	<p>The residents of 31 Milford St are interested in installing two small security cameras that are common in the area.</p> <p>The request for two cameras is due to range of view. Their locations have been proposed by a security professional with a reputable alarm company that services many residences in Boston. With an eye for helping make the second (lower) camera disappear it has been located in a shadowy area almost near ground level that would make it difficult to notice but clear to anyone descending the steps to below the stoop. The upper camera would have a clear view of all activity on the front steps as well as the gate at which the family locks their bike(s) regularly, both in the daytime and in the nighttime.</p> <p>The cameras will be painted to match the gray mortar between the bricks, helping them disappear into their surroundings.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Recent attempted break in (photos) and general concern over criminal activity in the immediate area - Two young children in the home that often commute by foot to local activities - Inability to put quality cameras inside the home to view the exterior through a window - Multiple bikes stolen and attempts on current bike - Regular absence from the home leaving it unattended for up to 1 or more weeks at a time.
