## HEARING NOTICE

March 10, 2022

The Boston City Council's Committee on Government Operations will hold a hearing on **Monday, March 28, 2022 at 10:00am**. This hearing will be held virtually.

The subject of the hearing is: ***Docket #0239, an ordinance creating a commission to study and develop reparation proposals for African Americans.***

This matter was referred to the Committee on February 2, 2022. The sponsors of the docket are Councilors Julia Mejia, Tania Fernandes Anderson, and Brian Worrell.

NOTICE: The Boston City Council may have a quorum in attendance due to standing committees of the City Council consisting of both voting and non-voting members. However, members attending this duly posted hearing are participating and deliberating only in conjunction with the business of the standing committee.

**Attendance:** In accordance with Chapter 22 of the Acts of 2022 modifying certain requirements of the Open Meeting Law and relieving public bodies of certain requirements, including the requirement that public bodies conduct its meetings in a public place that is open and physically accessible to the public, the City Council will be conducting this hearing virtually. This enables the City Council to carry out its responsibilities while adhering to public health accommodations and ensuring public access to its deliberations through adequate, alternative means.
