The Boston City Council's Committee on City Services and Innovation Technology will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, April 19, 2022 at 10:00 AM in the Iannella Chamber, 5th floor, Boston City Hall.

The subjects of the hearing are:

Docket #0402, message and order for a supplemental appropriation of Two Million Nine Hundred Fifty Four Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty Eight Dollars (\$2,954,828.00) to cover the FY22 cost items contained within the collective bargaining agreement between the City of Boston and AFSCME.

Docket #0403, message and order to reduce the FY22 appropriation for the Reserve for Collective bargaining by Two Million Nine Hundred Fifty Four Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty Eight Dollars (\$2,954,828.00) to provide funding for various departments for FY22 increases contained within the collective bargaining agreements between the City of Boston and AFSCME.

These matters were sponsored by the Administration and referred to the Committee on March 23, 2022.
