Constructed in 1899-1900 on a vacant lot by architect Alfred J. Manning with designer Louis Comfort Tiffany for Frederick Ayer and his wife Ellen Barrows (Banning) Ayer. They Ayers lived in the mansion until their deaths in 1918.

1923 Aquired by the E. A. Abbott Company and converted to offices.

1939 foreclosure by Brookline Savings Bank after continued use as medical offices by several owners.

1958 acquired along with 397 Commonwealth by Hearthstone Insurance, buildings operated as single building with various offices.

1964 acquired by the Association for Cultural Interchange for use as a dormitory in conjunction with 397 Commonwealth.

1966 added to the State Register for Historic Places


1988 300 square foot addition to the chapel created extending onto the 397 Commonwealth lot

2005 designated a National Historic Landmark as one of three surviving examples of residential interiors deisgned by Louis Comfort Tiffany.

One of only twelve Back Bay addresses to have frontage on both Commonwealth Avenue and Marlborough Street.



Copper clad entry door, dents cannot be repaired, copper is not punctured




Fire department beacon to be removed



Basement wood door and windows, to be retained and refurbished.












