PUBLIC HEARING BOSTON AIR POLLUTION CONTROL COMMISSION June 15, 2022

In accordance with the Procedures and Criteria for the Issuance of Parking Freeze Permits adopted under M.G.L. Chapter 111, Section 31C, and pursuant to the Building Emissions Reduction and Disclosure Ordinance, Boston City Code, Ordinances, Section 7-2.2, the City of Boston Air Pollution Control Commission will hold a virtual public hearing at 11:00 a.m. on June 15, 2022, to review the following projects to regulate and control air pollution so as to promote the public health and welfare of Boston residents.

Any matter posted as part of a public hearing may be deliberated on at a subsequent meeting.

APPLICATIONS:

Application for a Modified East Boston Parking Freeze Permit from VHB on behalf of Cargo Ventures LLC for 575 park and fly spaces. This permit is to relocate spaces from a surface lot at 320 McClellan Highway to a new parking garage at 440 McClellan Highway. Modification of the permit would have no effect on the East Boston parking freeze bank. *Continued to an upcoming meeting

Application for a Modified East Boston Parking Freeze Permit from VHB on behalf of Cargo Ventures LLC for 127 park and fly spaces. This permit is to relocate spaces from a surface lot at 380 McClellan Highway to a new parking garage at 440 McClellan Highway. Modification of the permit would have no effect on the East Boston parking freeze bank. *Continued to an upcoming meeting

Application for a New South Boston Parking Freeze Exemption Certification from Bozzuto Management Company on behalf of 411 D St Associates LLC for 5 residential included parking spaces located at 411 D St. This facility consists of five (5) inventoried residential parking spaces and 122 excluded residential parking spaces in an above-ground parking garage. Spaces would be used for potential tenants of Flats on D. Issuance of the permit would withdraw five (5) spaces from the South Boston parking freeze bank.
