CONCERNS WE HAVE HEARD

- **Transit Delays:** Peak period congestion causes buses to slow down.
- **Dangerous Turns:** Some turns are very wide and cause traffic to make them quickly.
- **Parking:** Vital to keep on street parking on HPA, even if it's unusable in winter.
- **Construction:** Maintenance and construction projects make travel hard.
- **Traffic Signals:** Timing on some signals could be improved for traffic and pedestrians.

MENU OF POTENTIAL IMPROVEMENTS

- **Transit Enhancements:** Enhancements could include: improved bus stops, signal timing, and a bus/bike lane at key areas to expedite bus travel.
- **Signal Timing:** Signals could be improved to help pedestrians cross the street and improve traffic flow.
- **Intersection Safety:** Intersections could be evaluated to improve safety for all users.
