# 30 Bradford Current Entry

Currently the front entry of 30 Bradford is pushed back in the doorway

The proposal is to pull the door forward, level with front of building and with street





### **Bradford Street Neighborhood**



By bringing the door forward,

30 Bradford would be "in line" with the look of its neighbors on Bradford St




### **Direct Neighbors**






### Historic Photo: Front Entry

#### Front Doors

The current front entry doors would be reused, simply brought forward to street level.

Other materials used would be wood trim, studs, moldings to match existing door, and paint.



## Building Process:

- Remove doors & casing
- Reconstruct casing to same measurements as existing wall frame
- Install existing doors into casing
- Paint trim
- Install transom window
