

DAVID MUGAR SCULPTURE

- The sculpture will be a tribute to the life and legacy of David in recognition for everything he accomplished and did in Boston for the greater good of his community.
- The sculpture will try to express David's inner spirit, his warm and humble nature, and his love for other people.
- The scale and dimensions of the sculpture and base will be comparable to the other monuments near the Hatch Shell.
- The sculpture will be designed to be interactive, and a narrative element will be incorporated into the depiction.
- The projected schedule is to complete some preliminary site work in 2022 and to dedicate the sculpture sometime in 2023.
- The entire substructure, bronze, and stone will be made and constructed of the highest quality of materials that will require minimal maintenance.
- The Mugar family and sculpture committee, the State, City or State agencies, and the like will be welcome to review the design and the progress of the work during the process at any time.



Vandal Resistant Coatings Bronze


The bronze will have protective coatings including two coats of Incralac and two coats of high-quality clear wax.

- Incralac is the surface coating as recommended by the International Copper Association as the best protection for the effects of airborne pollution, pollen, and acid rain on outdoor bronze sculptures.
- Two coats of a high-quality clear paste wax will be applied over the Incralac. The wax protects the Incralac and provides a barrier coating which would make any applied vandalizing paint easily removable.

Granite

The surface of granite with a natural or steeled finish is porous and subject to being stained or contaminated with paint/oil or graffiti. Our recommendation is to use a honed finish which is a more polished surface, less porous and easier to successfully remove graffiti.





