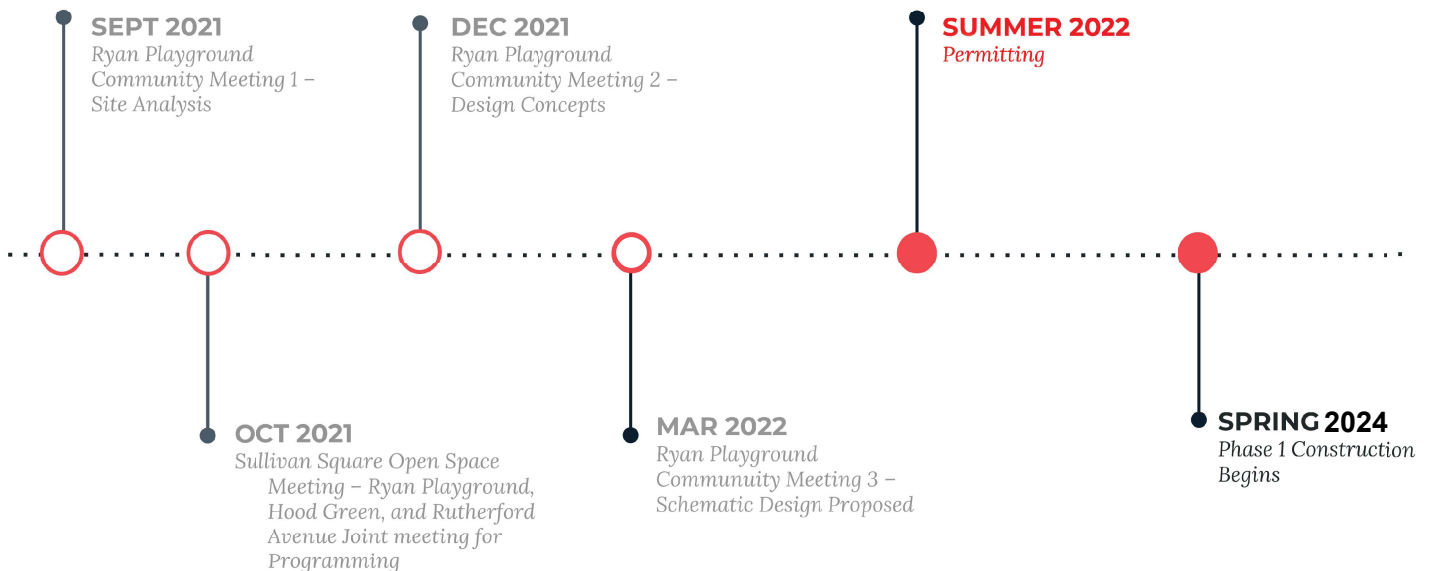
SCHEDULE UPDATE:

Our project has a number of permits that we need to obtain before construction starts. We've just started our first submission, which is Massachusetts Environmental Protection Agency (MEPA). There are a number of new requirements for this permit as of January 2022, and so our project timeline is now shifting.

We anticipate receiving all permits necessary for construction by **SPRING 2024**, one year later than we originally thought.

Parks will continue to work with Little League, Softball and Baseball to try to secure fields during construction, when Ryan Playground fields are not usable.

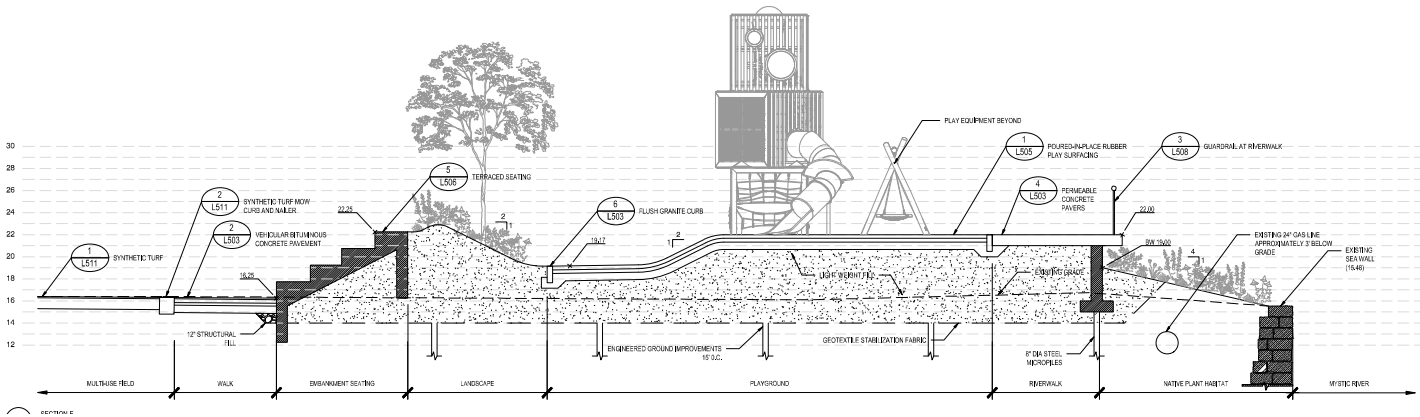
PROJECT SCHEDULE
