The subject of the hearing is: Dockets #1017, Message and order for your approval a home rule petition to the General Court entitled "Petition for a Special Law Re: An Act Authorizing the City of Boston to Establish Fossil Fuel-Free Standards for New Construction and Major Renovation Projects." This matter was sponsored by the Administration and referred to the Committee on August 31, 2022.
