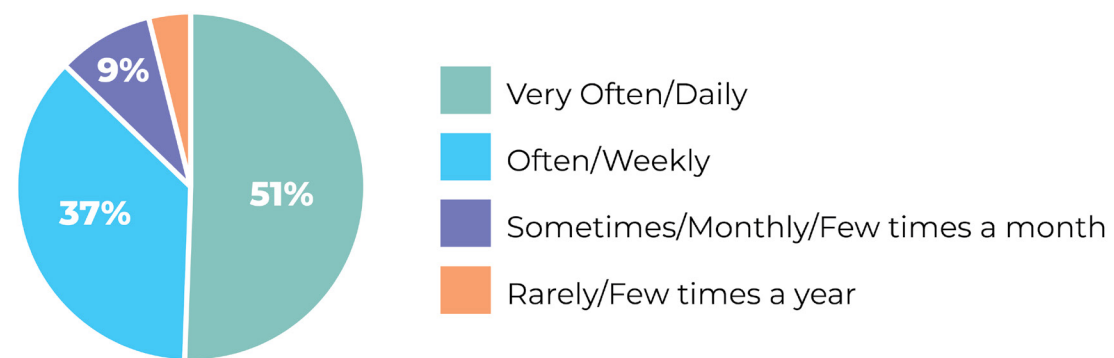

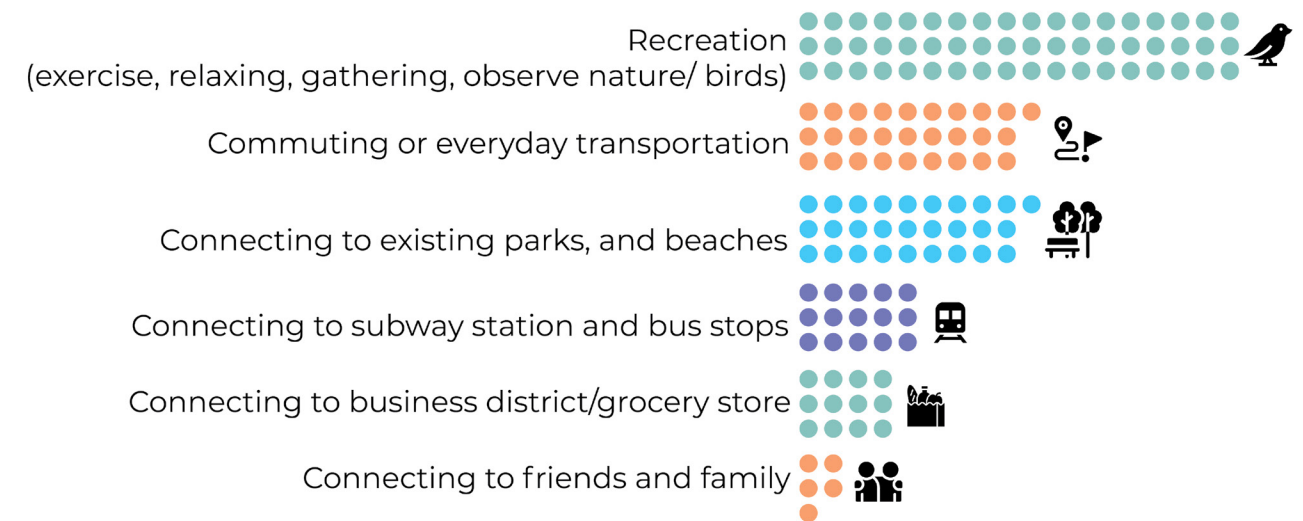

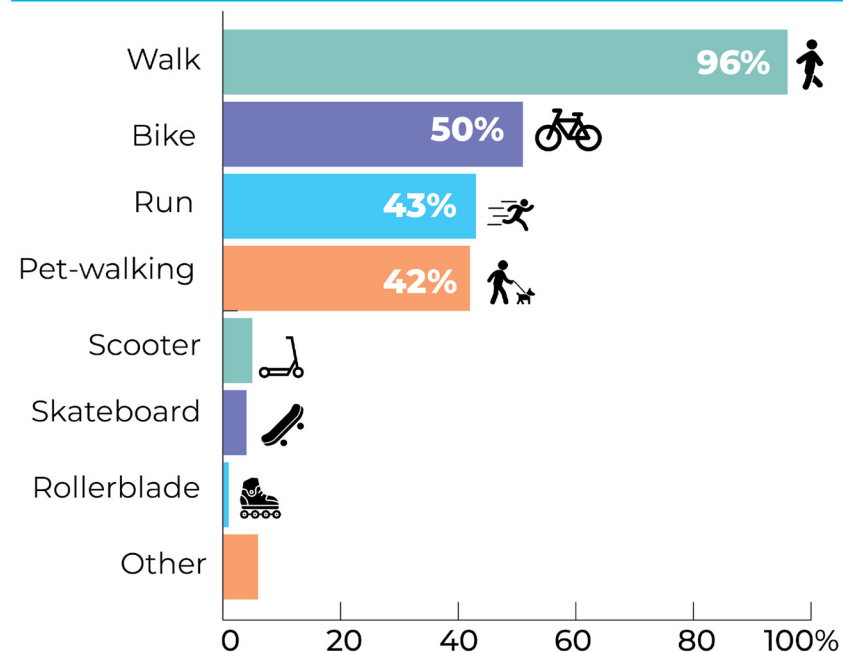
How frequently do you use the Mary Ellen Welch Greenway?



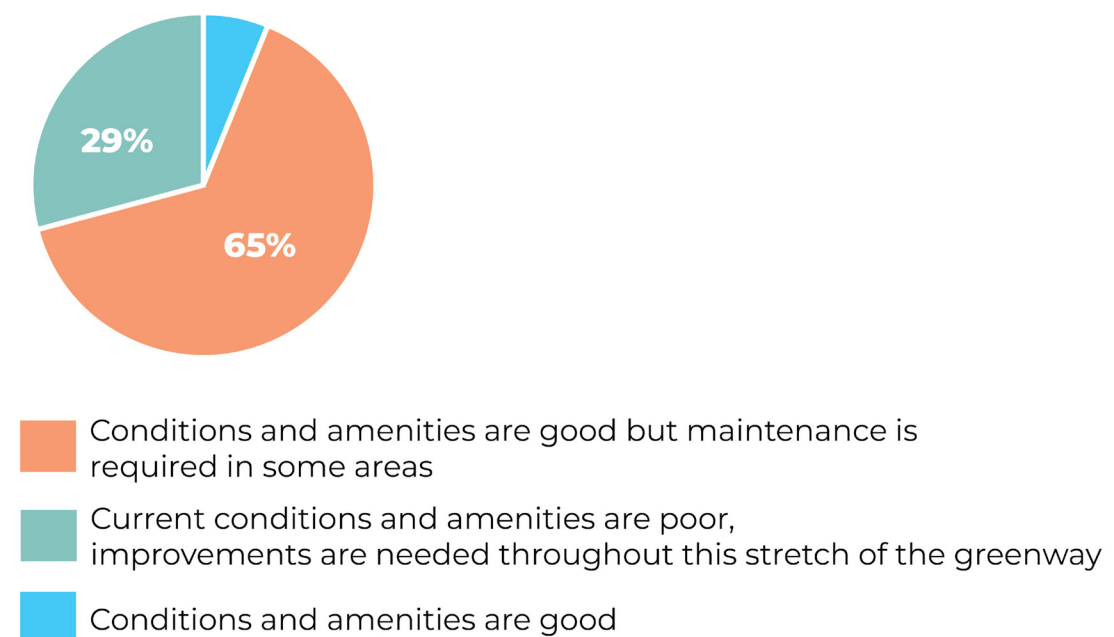
For what purpose do you typically use the greenway?

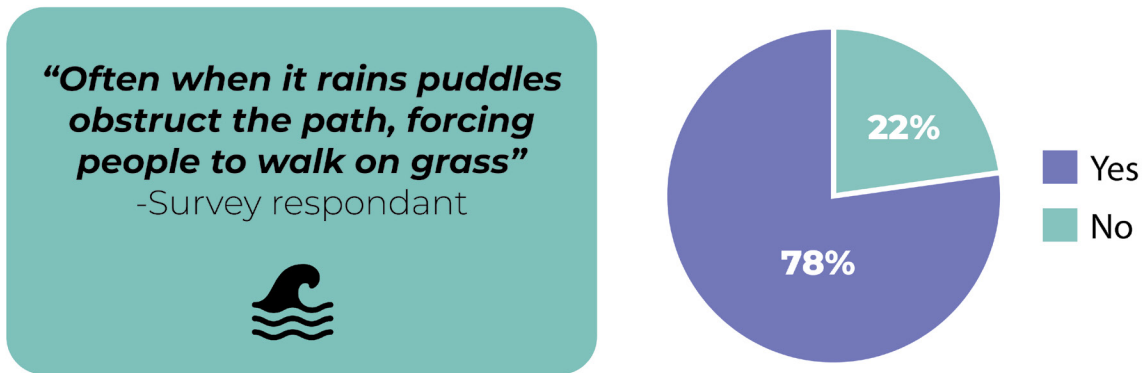

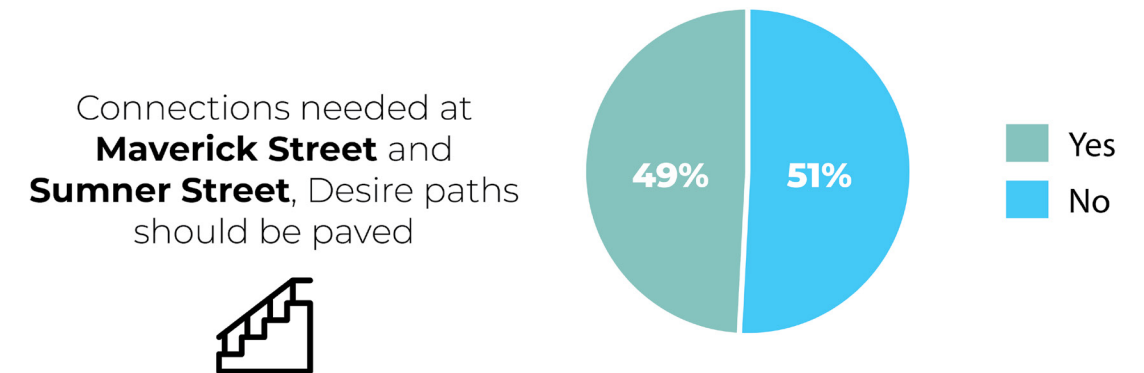

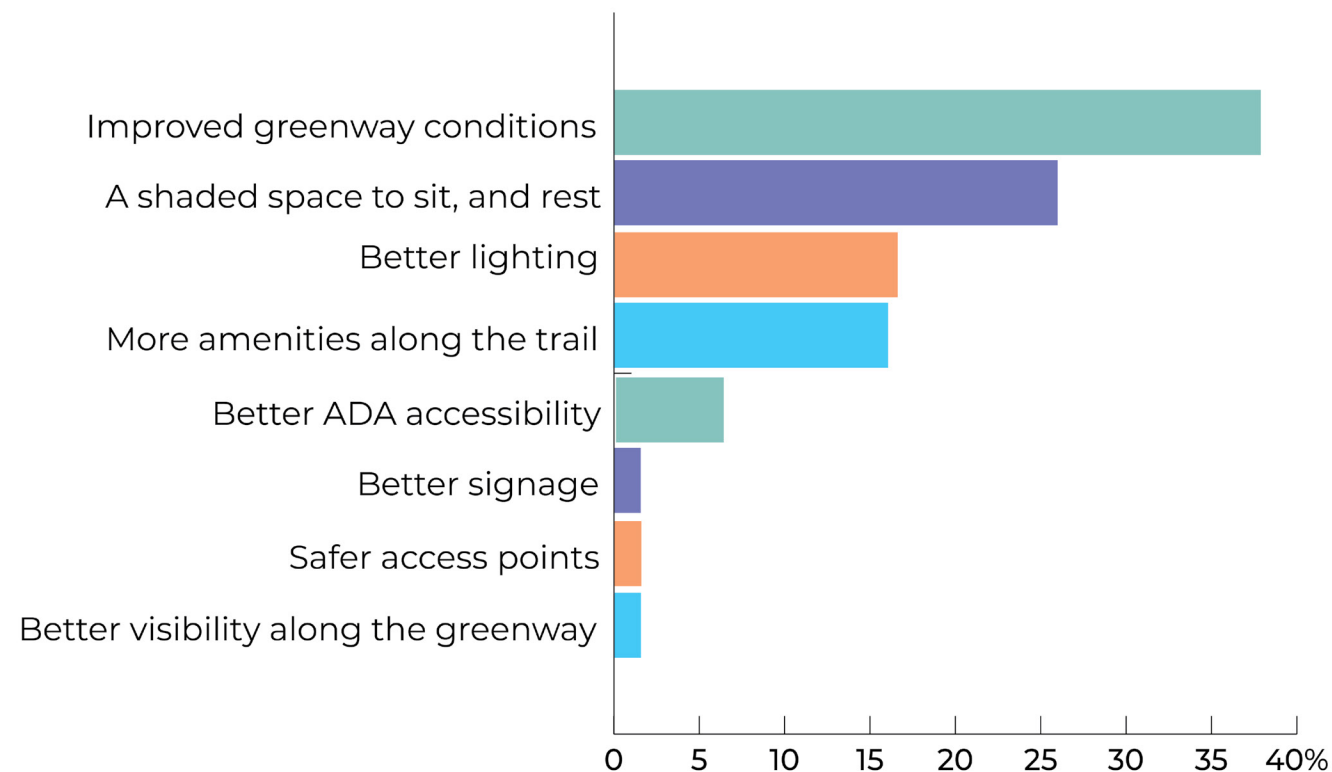

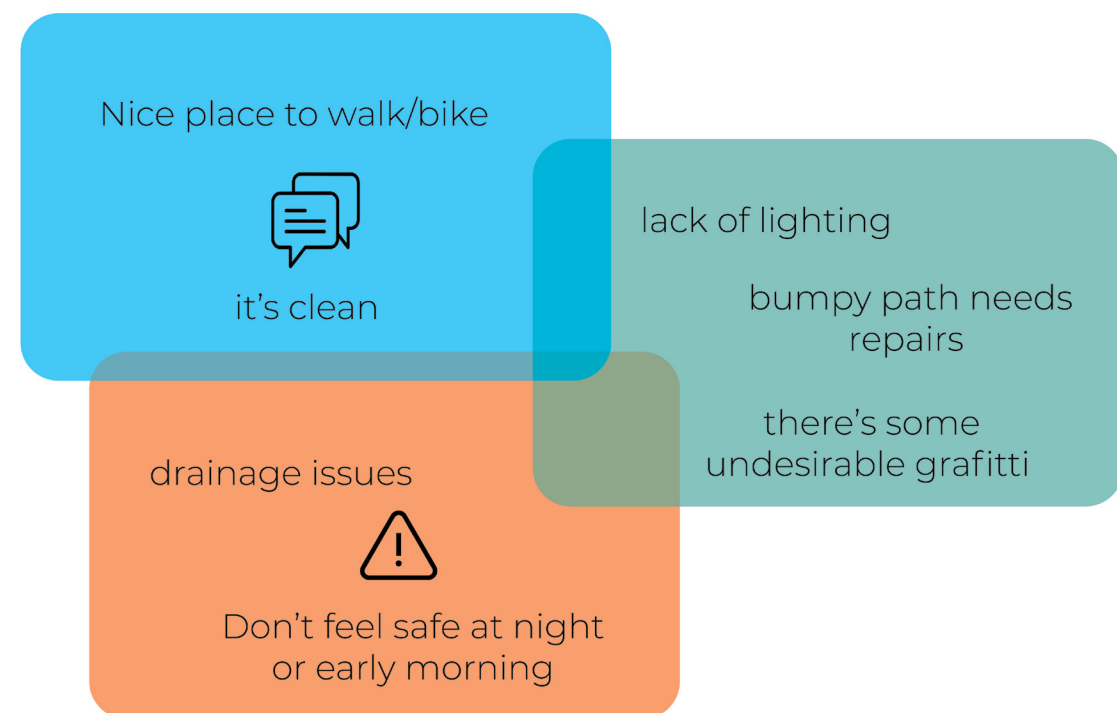

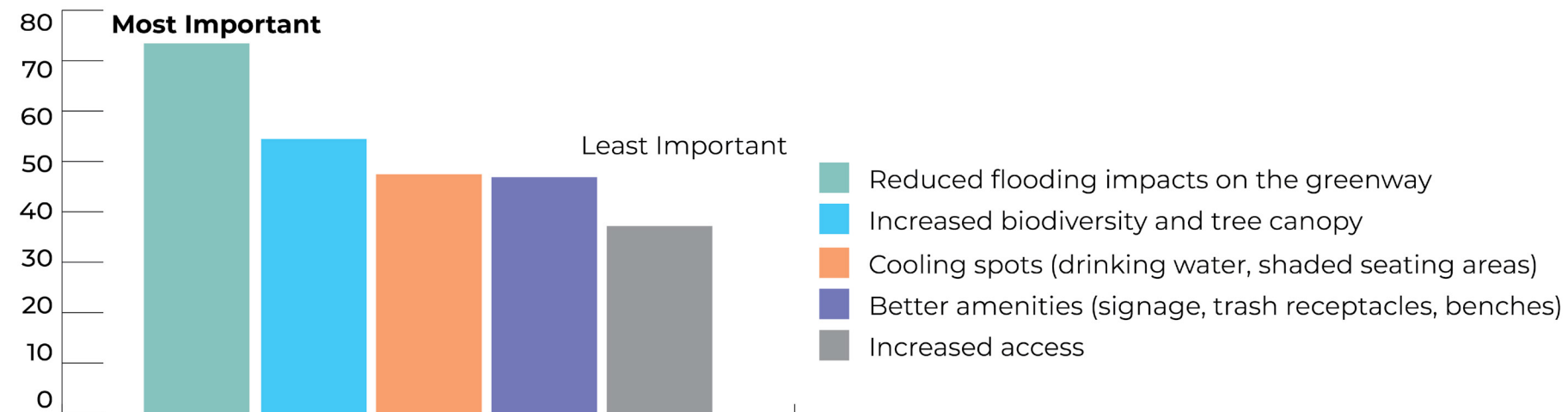
