



ERC – Diversity, Equity and Inclusion



Tishman Speyer's ERC team is dedicated to building a neighborhood that works for the community - a new model for inclusive, equitable, and community focused development. A key focus has been to integrate Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) into each phase of the development. Components of the ERC - DEI strategic plan include:

JOB CREATION

The ERC project is estimated to create 2,000 construction jobs in a variety of trades, and 2,300 permanent on-site jobs in a variety of fields including life sciences, building operations, retail, and hospitality.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

The team is working to establish a workforce development plan to increase opportunities for Allston-Brighton residents, minorities and women in the construction, life sciences and commercial real estate industries. The ERC team is committed to offering local A/B high schools such as Brighton High and Boston Green Academy career exploration programs in life science, and design & construction.

INCLUSIVE EQUITY OWNERSHIP

Tishman Speyer has raised ~\$30 million in equity, equal to 5% of the project equity, from over 150 Black and Latinx households from a wide range of backgrounds and professions, including local Bostonians. This represents the first opportunity for many to invest in a large-scale development project of this nature.

LOCAL RETAIL AND CULTURAL USES

25% of retail set aside for local, small, minority-owned, and/or women-owned businesses (MBE/WBEs). Approximately 1,500 SF ground floor retail space in the Proposed Phase A Project designated as a flexible arts space that will include a rotating program of art and cultural uses.

SUPPLIER DIVERSITY

Tishman Speyer is also making DE&I in the design, construction and operations procurement process a priority to boost participation by MBE/WBEs. During our design phase, the team awarded more than 30% of project design costs to date to certified MBE and WBE firms. During the construction phase of the ERC, we have committed to award at least 15% of its construction cost to certified MBE and WBE firms

During the permitting process Tishman Speyer committed to **15% M/WBE participation**. The Consigli/Smoot team prioritized M/WBE outreach and participation throughout the bidding and procurement process, requiring **all bidders** to provide MBE and WBE participation options. Currently, the project is **80% bought out** and we are on target to exceed the 15% goal. We have **15** Executed prime subcontract agreements which include the award of **19 M/WBE** firms at both the prime and sub-tier level.

Subcontractor's BRJP historical reports are reviewed prior to awarding contracts. Subcontractors/Trade Partners are required to submit a workforce compliance plan once the contract has been awarded.

As a standard practice, Consigli/Smoot specifically discusses the BRJP employment standards with all subs prior to their contract award.

All subcontractors are provided with the BRJP pre-construction package. Prior to attending the preconstruction meeting the subcontractor provides Consigli with their contact responsible for their workforce onsite and their contact responsible for submitting weekly reports.



BRJP is an agenda item at our weekly subcontractor and owner meetings where the projects actual goals and concerns regarding workforce are discussed.
