

THE PROJECT & PROCESS

As part of the City of Boston Parks and Recreation Department's continuing effort to provide quality open space and recreation areas for use and enjoyment by all residents of the city. The process will include input and collaboration from the community through a series of meetings facilitated by Boston Parks and Recreation and the design firm, Ground, Inc.

Tonight's meeting will include a brief presentation of the project scope and community members will be able to offer input regarding the material presented, the program for the park, and the design process. The anticipated project scope includes: updated play equipment including potential water play, streetscape and entrance beautification, improving underutilized park open space, new site furnishings, vegetation management and integration of existing and desired activities and amenities.

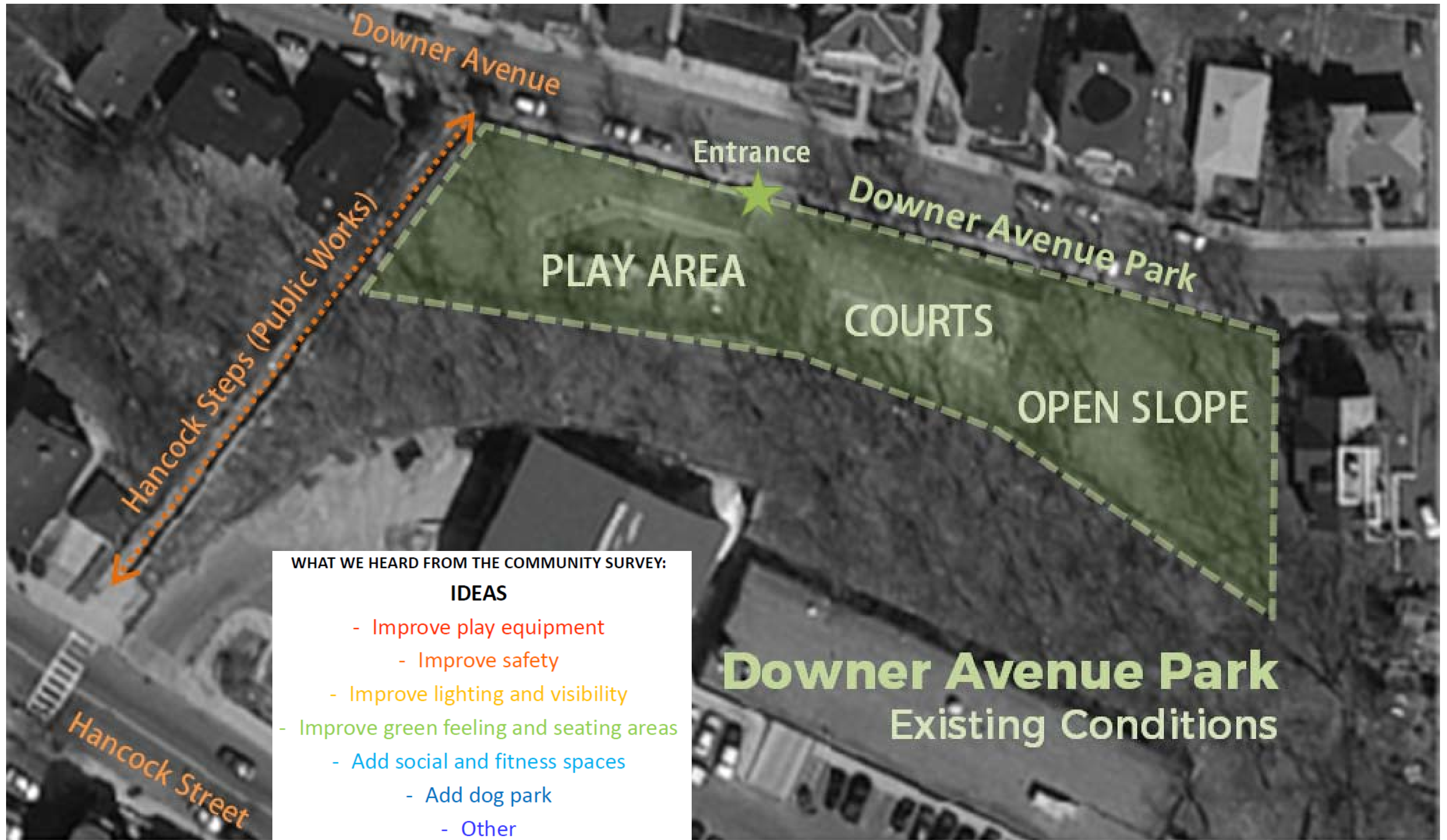
