I. DESIGN REVIEW

17.1520 AB 101-103 Kilsyth Road

Applicant: Jaime Krofta, Michael Kim Associates

Proposed Work: Construct a one-story rear yard addition and deck.

- II. ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW/APPROVAL: In order to expedite the review process, the commission has delegated the approval of certain work items, such as those involving ordinary maintenance and repair, restoration or replacement, or which otherwise have a minimal impact on a building's appearance, to the commission staff pending ratification at its monthly public hearing. Having been identified as meeting these eligibility criteria and all applicable guidelines, the following applications will be approved at this hearing:
 - Applicants whose projects are listed under this heading **NEED NOT APPEAR** at the hearing. Following the hearing, you will be issued a Determination Sheet to present at the Inspectional Services Department (1010 Massachusetts Avenue) as proof of project approval when applying for permits. ISD personnel will send an electronic copy of your

building-permit application to the commission staff for review. (To avoid potential confusion, the text of your building-permit application should be consistent with the project description given below.) Commission staff will accordingly authorize the execution of the work, attaching any applicable provisos, reflecting the relevant guidelines and precedents.

▶ PLEASE NOTE THAT FOLLOWING ISSUANCE OF THE DETERMINATION SHEET NO FURTHER CORRESPONDENCE WILL BE ISSUED FOR THE APPLICATIONS LISTED BELOW. The electronic building-permit application as annotated by commission staff will constitute your Certificate of Design Approval; this will be valid for two years from the date of the hearing. The applicant is required to notify the commission of any project changes; failure to do so may affect the status of the approval.

- 17.995 AB <u>210 Chestnut Hill Avenue</u>: Repoint; replace deteriorated stone headers with tinted precast units; and resurface the stone base of the building using a tinted cementitious stucco.
- 17.1047 AB 286-288 Chestnut Hill Avenue: Replace shrubs within the front areaway.
- 17.1514 AB 370-374 Chestnut Hill Avenue, aka 2-6 Sutherland Road: Repair and repaint the fire escapes and fire balconies in-kind.
- 17.1463 AB 12-14 Chiswick Road: Replace deteriorated sections of the wood gutter and fascia in-kind.
