I WANT TO WELCOME COMMISSIONER EMILY -- TO DISCUSS -- TODAY THE COMMITTEE WILL DISCUSS DOCKET 1375, MESSAGE AND ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EBBS PENNED THE AMOUNT OF \$1,257,011.60 IN THE FORM OF A GRANT. SUPPORTIVE SERVICES -- BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES -- EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF ELDER AFFAIRS TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE ELDERLY COMMISSION. WILL FUND A COMPREHENSIVE AND COORDINATED HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICE SUBPOENA WHICH IS ELDERS AND MAINTAINING INDEPENDENT LIVING IN THEIR OWN COMMUNITY AS LONG AS DESIRED. AND DOCKET 1376, MESSAGE AND ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF

BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT OF \$474,233.75 FOR THE AREA PLAN ADMINISTRATION AWARDED BY U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES PASSED THROUGH THE MASS EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF AFFAIRS TO BE ADMINISTERED BY

THE ELDERLY COMMISSION. FUND EXPENSES OF THE AGENCY ON AGING.

I HOPE WHAT YOU HAVE IS MORE SUCCINCT AND COMPELLING THAN WHAT I READ. IT IS A TONGUE TWISTER.

>> I WOULD NOW LIKE TO TURN IT OVER TO THE COMMISSIONER AND OVERVIEW OF THE PLANS AND THE PROGRAMS THEY WILL SUPPORT. >> SURE.

THANK YOU, COUNSELOR.

I REALLY AM EXCITED TO BE HERE TODAY.

AS YOU SAID, WE ARE BOSTON AREA AGENCY ON AGING, OR TRIPLE A WHICH MEANS THE FUNDS TO THE OLDER AMERICANS ACT COME TO US, AND WE ARE VERY PROUD TO SAY, GO BACK OUT INTO THE COMMUNITY SO MOST OF THESE ARE PASS THROUGH FUNDS FOR US FOR DOCKET NUMBER 1375, FOR SUPPORTIVE SERVICES, WE FUND, WE KEEP SOME MONEY IN-HOUSE, WHICH PRIMARILY FUNDS OUR COMMUNITY SERVICE ADVOCATES WHO ARE OUT PROVIDING BENEFITS APPLICATION ASSISTANCE, INFORMATION, CONNECTING SENIORS TO RESOURCES THAT THEY NEED OUT IN THE COMMUNITY. AND THEN WE GIVE OUT 30 COMMUNITY GRANTS.

WE HAVE 30 GRANTEES FOR THIS FUNDING.

SO I AM NOT GOING TO GO INTO ALL OF THE GRANT TEASE, GRANTEES BUT A PORTION OF THE MONEY .. IS SET ASIDE AS MANDATED BY THE STATE AND FRANKLY VERY WELL DESERVED FOR LEGAL SERVICES, SO LEGAL SERVICES TO SUPPORT OLDER ADULTS WHO MAY HAVE THEIR HEAT TURNED OFF OR LIGHTS TURNED OFF OR NEED ASSISTANCE KIND OF NAVIGATING SYSTEMS AND GETTING LEGAL SUPPORT FOR THEM.

WE FUND SENIOR PROGRAMMING IN BOSTON, SO WE TRY TO BE -- WE TRY TO FUND THINGS ACROSS ALL NEIGHBORHOODS OF THE CITY, FUNDING DIFFERENT PROGRAMS THAT OLDER ADULT ACCOUNTS PARTICIPATE

IN, WHETHER THAT IS EXERCISE PROGRAMS, OTHER RECREATION, WITHIN THOSE PROGRAMS, WE FUND SERVICES LIKE TRANSLATION AND INTERPRETATION, SO A PROGRAM MAY BE HELPING AN OLDER ADULT KIND OF READ THEIR MAIL OR COMMUNICATE WITH PEOPLE THEY NEED TO COMMUNICATE WITH. WE DO HOUSING ASSISTANCE WITH THAT FUNDING, SO SOME HOUSING SEARCH AND APPLICATION ASSISTANCE AND ALSO SOME SENIOR HOME REPAIR. SO IT JUST IS A REAL RANGE OF

THINGS WE PUT OUT.

WE HAVE A WHOLE GRANT MAKING PROCESS, WHERE PROVIDERS CAN APPLY TO BE ONE OF OUR GRANTEES WITH THIS MONEY.

SO VERY KIND OF ABOVEBOARD TRANSPARENT PROCESS SO WE MAKE SURE WE ARE USING THE FUNDS WISELY AND SO THAT WE CAN MAKE SURE THEY ARE GOING TO MEET THE NEEDS OF THE OLDER POPULATION. >> SHOULD I MOVE ON TO THE SECOND ONE?

>> I JUST HAD A QUICK QUESTION BEFORE YOU ADVANCE FORWARD. COULD YOU JUST SPEAK TO THE SERVICES THAT THIS GRANT WOULD FUND OR ARE SO CRITICAL IN MANY WAYS PHYSICAL VERY CREATIVE, SO WE WANT TO MAKE SURE WE ARE MEETING THE CONTINUUM OF ELDER SUPPORT IN THE CITY AND HELP PEOPLE AGING IN THE COMMUNITY AND REMAINING INDEPENDENT AND CONNECTED IS SO IMPORTANT. HOW DO WE MAKE SURE THAT IS TRUE AND EQUITABLY THE CASE? CAN YOU SPEAK A LITTLE BIT TO THE APPLICATION OF THESE GRANTS

>> YES, SURE.

GEOGRAPHY?

SO -- SO WHAT I CAN SAY IS THAT WE, AS PART OF OUR GRANT MAKING PROCESS, WE DO LOOK TO MAKE SURE THAT WE ARE TARGETING .., THAT WE ARE ABLE TO PROVIDE SERVICE IN ALL DIFFERENT AREAS OF THE

AND IF THEY ARE TARGETED TOWARD A SPECIFIC NEIGHBORHOOD OR

CITY, SO WE HAVE, WHEN PEOPLE APPLY FOR THE GRANT FROM US, WE HAVE A WHOLE KIND OF READING AND SCREENING TOOL WHERE WE HAVE MULTIPLE READERS SO IT IS A WHOLE PROCESS LIKE THAT. BUT THEN WE ADD KIND OF AN EXTRA LAYER INTO LOOKING AT THAT TO LOOK AT OUR GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION OF GRANTS SO WE CAN MAKE SURE SENIORS IN ALL AREAS OF THE CITY ARE GETTING SERVED. I WILL ADD ANOTHER LITTLE PIECE TO THAT. WHICH IS TO POTENTIALLY BE MORE THAN YOU WANT TO KNOW, BUT WE ARE RESPONSIBLE AS THE TRIPLE A FOR DOING A NEEDS ASSESSMENT EVERY FOUR YEARS, SO UNDERSTANDING THE NEEDS OF THE COMMUNITY, PARTICULARLY OUR LOWER INCOME, OLDER ADULTS, AND ALSO WITHIN THAT NEEDS ASSESSMENT THEN WE ARE CRAFTING SOMETHING CALLED AN AREA PLAN, AND SOME OF THAT THEN IS USED TO KIND OF GUIDE HOW WE MAKE DECISIONS ON GRANT MAKING. >> AND JUST CONTEXTUALLY OUT OF BASIC CURIOSITY, I MEAN I KNOW BABY BOOMER POPULATION IS BOOMING, RIGHT? >> SURE IS. >> THAT'S WHY THE CITY IS SO COMMITTED TO MAKE SURE THAT WE ARE AGING WELL. SOME PEOPLE, THANK GOD MANY PEOPLE LIVE MUCH LONGER. I AM CURIOUS DOES THE ELDER POPULATION LIVE IN ONE COMMUNITY MORE THAN ANOTHER? >> WE ANECDOTALLY BELIEVE IT IS TRUE BUT I WANT TO HEAR IT OFFICIALLY FROM YOU. >> SO WHAT I WOULD SAY IS THE LAST KIND OF OFFICIAL NUMBER IN THE NEIGHBORHOODS ARE BASED ON 2010 AND WE HAVE GROWN, WE HAD ABOUT 88,000 OLDER ADULTS NOW.

BUT WHAT I WILL SAY IS WEST ROXBURY HAS THE OLDER PERCENTAGE

THEY ESTIMATE IN 2015 WE HAD ABOUT 103,000 SO WE HAVE GROWN EXPONENTIALLY FOR FOLKS OVER THE

AGE OF 60.

OF OLDER ADULTS SO BACK IN 2010 THEY WERE 24 PERCENT OVER 60. DORCHESTER OBVIOUSLY HAS THE LARGEST NUMBER OF OLDER ADULTS, JUST BECAUSE IT IS OUR BIGGEST NEIGHBORHOOD.

BUT WE DO HAVE THOSE STATISTICS AVAILABLE ON OUR WEBSITE.

WE DID A DATA REPORT THAT WE
HAVE UP ON OUR WEBSITE THAT
