PARKS DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES ROXBURY TREE REMOVAL HEARING

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 87, the Boston Parks and Recreation Department will hold a public hearing on Thursday, December 6, at 10:30 a.m. on a request to remove one public shade tree at 56 Cedar Street in Roxbury.

The hearing will be held by the City of Boston's Tree Warden (or designee) in the 3rd floor Conference Room of the Boston Parks and Recreation Department at 1010 Massachusetts Avenue, Roxbury.

The request is for the removal of one honey locust tree measuring 8 inches dbh (diameter at breast height) to facilitate installation of a curb cut as part of construction of a three story residential building at 56 Cedar Street.

Public testimony will be taken at the hearing, or may be provided prior to the hearing in writing to the Tree Warden, Boston Parks and Recreation Department, 1010 Massachusetts Avenue, 3rd floor, Boston, MA 02118 or by emailing parks@boston.gov with "Roxbury Tree Hearing" in the subject line.
