**AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE BOSTON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT
TO UTILIZE FUNDS FROM THE GEORGE FRANCIS PARKMAN FUND**

ORDERED: That the sum of ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,200,000.00) be, and the same hereby is, appropriated from the income of the George Francis Parkman Fund to be expended in FY20 at the direction of the Commissioner of Parks and Recreation as follows:

For the general care and maintenance of the Boston Common and Parks in existence as of January 12, 1887. \$950,000.00

For the specialized maintenance of the horticulture and infrastructure of the Boston Common and Parks in existence as of January 12, 1887. \$224,000.00

For equipment, infrastructure improvements and repairs in the Boston Common and Parks in existence as of January 12, 1887. \$26,000.00
