AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND Senior Companion Program 2019 FUNDS, AWARDED BY Corporation for National and Community Service

WHEREAS, the Corporation for National and Community Service, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Elderly Commission; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE DOLLARS (**\$262,763.00**) would fund part-time stipendiary community service opportunities for low-income persons who are 60 years and older, Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the Corporation for National and Community Service, Senior Companion Program 2019 award not to exceed the amount of TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE DOLLARS (**\$262,763.00**).
