PARKS DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES WEST END TREE REMOVAL HEARING

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 87, the Boston Parks and Recreation Department will hold a public hearing on Thursday, November 7, on a request to remove four public shade trees in Boston's West End.

The hearing will be held by the City of Boston's Tree Warden (or designee) in the 3rd floor Conference Room of the Boston Parks and Recreation Department at 1010 Massachusetts Avenue, Roxbury.

The hearing will be held at 10:30 a.m. to consider a request for the removal of four honey locust trees each measuring 3 inches dbh (diameter at breast height) to facilitate construction of a new left lane turn on Lomasney Way in the West End.

Public testimony will be taken at the hearing, or may be provided prior to the hearing in writing to the Tree Warden, Boston Parks and Recreation Department, 1010 Massachusetts Avenue, 3rd floor, Roxbury, MA 02118 or by emailing parks@boston.gov with "West End Tree Hearing" in the subject line.
