ORDER FOR A HEARING REGARDING PROHIBITING WEARING A MASK, HOOD OR OTHER DEVICE TO CONEAL ANY PORTION OF THE FACE TO CONCEAL THE IDENTITY OF THE WEARER UPON OR WITHIN PUBLIC PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF BOSTON

- WHEREAS, Last week, Boston, was met with counter-protesters which led to Boston Police Officers being injured and thirty six arrests. and
- WHEREAS, Many protesters came from outside of Boston and many wore masks disguising their faces; and
- WHEREAS, These protesters were not in Boston for a peaceful comment on a certain parade, they were here to cause violence, they were here to attack Boston Police Officers, attack the City of Boston itself; and
- WHEREAS, These protesters will appear in court facing charges from assault and battery with a dangerous weapon, carrying a dangerous weapon, resisting arrest and disorderly conduct. Nine are accused of assaulting a police officer with four officers injured: and
- WHEREAS, The Boston Herald witnessed protesters in altercations with police and one selfidentified member of the hard-left group Antifa told the Herald that violence "masked", is necessary to "shut up" the parade organizers; and
- WHEREAS, Many states have laws governing the wearing of mask or face coverings including New York, California, Virginia and Massachusetts; and
- WHEREAS, The Code of Virginia Law 18.2-422. Prohibition of wearing masks in certain places is the epitome of the purpose of this hearing

NOW,

THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED.

That the appropriate committee of the Boston City Council hold a hearing to discuss prohibiting the wearing of a mask, hood or other device to conceal any portion of the face to conceal the identity of the wearer upon or within Public Property in Boston. The Mayor's Office, Boston Police Department, Homeland Security, MA State Police, Boston Fire Dept., MBTA Police and other interested parties shall be invited to attend.
