ORDERED: That the sum of Six Hundred Ninety-Two Thousand Two Hundred Eight Dollars (\$692,208) be, and the same hereby is, appropriated from the income of the Edward Ingersoll Browne Fund, pursuant to a vote of the Edward Ingersoll Browne Fund Commission, and further that said sum be expended as follows:

To the Boston Foundation for design services of a sculpture celebrating Dr. Martin Luther King and Coretta Scott King to be located in the Boston Common\$100,000

To the Cocoanut Grove Memorial Committee for design collaboration of an artist and landscape architect to develop a design proposal commemorating the Cocoanut Grove Fire that occurred on November 18, 1942, to be located in the vicinity of Statler Park.....\$30,000

To the Brighton Gateway Improvement Committee for the reconstruction of the greenspace on Commonwealth Avenue and Father Herlihy Way in Brighton\$100,000

To the Friends of the Public Garden for the creation of new lighting for the Samuel Morison sculpture on Commonwealth Avenue Mall in Back Bay\$25,000

To the Old West Church for the redesign and reconstruction of the greenspace area surrounding the Old West Church.....\$100,000

To the Southwest Corridor Park Conservancy for hardscape improvements including the rehabilitation of an iron dry fountain and related paving.....\$20,000

To the Friends of Healy Field for the fabrication and installation of an ornamental fence and gateway at the Healy Field Community Garden in Roslindale\$33,060

To the Holocaust Memorial Committee for upgrades and landscape improvements to the Holocaust Memorial.....\$186,148

To the Massachusetts Fallen Heroes Memorial for the upgrade and artistic improvements to the Massachusetts Fallen Heroes Memorial located at the Seaport District on Northern Avenue\$98,000
