


Preparing for an emergency is like getting ready to go on an adventure. You need to make plans, get the supplies you need. Learn as much as you can about emergency situations before one really happens.



This is Freddy and this is where he lives.


Draw a picture of your house.




In an emergency you may have to leave your home quickly.

Draw your house and map out 2 paths out of your house.




In an emergency it is important to know who to call. Freddy is creating his family communication plan and writing down important numbers.



What IMPORTANT NUMBERS do you need to know?


Write down the numbers and practice calling them on the phone key pad.
