

CITY OF BOSTON SOLICITATION OF NEW CATY TELEVISION LICENSE

(Applications Due Back to City by Close of Business on May 16, 2016)

Introduction: Pursuant to Massachusetts Department of Tele-communications and Cable ("Department") regulations at 207 CMR §§ 3.02 and 3.03 and applicable State lations at 207 CWIK §§ 5.02 and 5.03 and appricators state and Federal cable television ("CATV") licensing and/or franchising laws and regulations, Mayor Martin J. Walsh, as CATV Issuing Authority for the City of Boston ("City"), hereby solicits applications for additional licensed providers of CATV services within the City.

Application Due Date/Time: (by May 16, 2016 at 5 p.m. EST). Thirty days from today

Form of Application/Resources: Applicants should pre-pare a complete Massachusetts State Form 100 CATV license application available at http://www.mass.gov/ ocabr/government/oca-agencies/dtc-lp/competition-division/cable-tv-division/applications-forms/. Applicants may also include supplemental materials in addition to required Form 100 information. Manner of Application:

a) To the Issuing Authority:

Additional Factors: The City reserves rights to give favorable consideration to applications that include one or more of the following: (1) terms that are "substantially the same" as those provided by Comcast (see Comcast License Section 2.4(b)); (2) payment of competitive fran-chise fee (e.g., five (5%) of gross revenue) or other finan-cial contributions; (3) provision to the City of institutional network capabilities; (4) use of advanced or innovative technologies for delivery of CATV and other services; (5) fiber expansions beyond those offered by existing providers; (6) competitive pricing relative to existing providers; (6) specific provision to provide service in public housing and low-income housing developments; (7) support for public access and digital literacy programs and organizations; (8) free or discounted services to the City or its residents, or non-profit community institutions; (9) affordability options for low income or other vulnerable consumers, and (10) other public interest elements.
